

Aluminum Outswing Sectional Guide Channel Sill

The guide channel sill is an option for when interior and exterior floors are at the same level. Compared to our standard outswing sill there is an approx. 5/16" gap between the bottom of the door panels and the floor. The guide channel sill option is for interior applications only it is not suitable for exterior use unless air infiltration is acceptable or there is no risk of water infiltration. Surface mounted sweeps on the bottom face of the door can be field applied by installer to reduce the gap under the doors, however, such sweeps are not effective for weather sealing. Also, refer to the LaCantina Doors zero step sill for an improved option for flush floor applications. ADA ramped sill option is also available upon request. Please note the net frame height will be measured from the bottom of the recessed channel and recessed area must accommodate 4" wide jamb legs.
